FAQ's

- 1. What ages are eligible to participate in the camp? Our golf camps are typically designed for juniors aged 6-17.
- 2. Do participants need prior golf experience? Prior experience is not necessary! We welcome beginners as well as experienced junior golfers. Our instructors tailor lessons to each participant's skill level.
- 3. What equipment is required? Golfers are encouraged to bring their own clubs if they have them. If not, we can provide equipment for use during the camp (limited availability).
- 4. What should my child wear to camp? Campers should wear comfortable golf attire, including golf shoes or sneakers. A hat and sunscreen are highly recommended for outdoor activities.
- 5. What does a typical day of camp look like? Each day includes a mix of instruction, practice, and fun activities. We cover the fundamentals along with time on the driving range, the indoor golf simulators and possibly the course.
- 6. Are meals or snacks provided? Lunch is included in the full day golf camp; the option to include lunch is available during the half day camp for an additional charge. Please ensure your child has a refillable water bottle.
- 7. How many kids are in each group? There are approximately 16 campers per session.
- 8. What is the cost of the camp? \$600/Session for the Full Day Golf Camp; \$400/Session for the Half Day Golf Camp. Lunch can be added to the half day camp for +\$75/session.

- 10. What is the refund or cancellation policy? Please contact us for details.
- 11. What safety measures are in place? Safety is a top priority. Instructors supervise all activities, and we ensure that all participants adhere to proper golf etiquette and safety protocols.
- 12. **Will my child get course time?** Yes, our camps include on-course play to give participants real-world golf experience, as well as practice on the driving range, in The Sims, and in the short game area.
